Clark Trophy: Stablefords -best 2 of 3 rounds
Home Penant: Best 3 stableford scores sent to W.G.O. on 4 occasions –Otago wide competition.
Stewart Jenkins Memorial: Club stableford competition, mixed
Jack & Noni Mead Trophy: Mixed partners
Jack and Noni Mead Trophy: Men & Women, choose own partners, 4BBB Bogey.
Harold Aitken Tray: Played for at club tournament, men & women. Best medal round over 27 holes.

MEN'S COMPETITIONS

Single Knock Out: Match play using difference in handicap. In event of a tie, extra holes to be played, sudden death, commencing at the hole where the match started.

Ringers Gross: Best score a player has on each hole over the season.

Ringers Nett: Best score a player has on a hole over the season but with handicap deducted. Handicap used shall be at the end of the season.

Putting: Number of putts taken on specified rounds. Best two results out of three added together.

Four Ball Best Ball: Stableford event played over three rounds, best 2 count, drawn partners for each round.

Deer Park Trophy: Choose own partner. Challengers play holders by putting names on list on notice board and playing Four Ball match play. In event of a tie the holders shall be deemed to have won. In the event of holders being unavailable for play for 2 consecutive weeks, they shall forfeit trophy to the challengers on top of the list. In the event of the challengers on the top of the list being unavailable for play the next names down may challenge.

Purvis Cup: Medal - Best 2 rounds out of 3 count.

Clark Trophy: Stableford - Best 2 out of 3 rounds count.

Brian Goodger Trophy: Best 6 Nett over season.

Allan Phillips Memorial: First 4 best of the year.

Eclectic: (Prize donated by Mrs E Davidson) Best score on each hole out of 2 nominated rounds.

CLUB COMPETITIONS

Championships: (Mens Grades - Senior 0-12, Intermediate 13-24, Junior 25-36 Sat 1st May cut off day for grades) Round robin played within each grade. Each match played over 18 holes. Points gained for wins, also bonus points (refer to rules on board in clubhouse). Players in each grade to play semifinals over 18 holes on date set in calendar (or upon player agreement on a date prior to set date).

Championship Final: 36 holes except Junior women play 18 holes. All finals to be played on the date set in the calendar. Upon mutual agreement players may play on a date prior to the set date.

Stewart Jenkins Memorial: Men and Women 18 hole Stableford.
